ORDINANCE NUMBER 2495-14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 29,
"SMOKE FREE POLICY" OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF
ROSELLE BY ADDING SECTION 29-1A "PROHIBITED CONDUCT IN PUBLIC
PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS, AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF ROSELLE IN THE COUNTY OF UNION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 29, "Smoke Free Policy", shall be and the same is hereby amended
as follows:

AMEND CHAPTER 29 "SMOKE FREE POLICY" is amended as follows:

ADD:

SECTION 29-1A "PROHIBITED CONDUCT IN PUBLIC PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS,
AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES:

Smoking shall be prohibited in all public parks, playgrounds, or other recreational
facilities of the Borough of Roselle, as well as being prohibited in all other facilities of the Borough
of Roselle where smoking is prohibited in accordance with N.J.S.A. 26:3D-55 *et seq.*, the New
Jersey Smoke-Free Air Act.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall
continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is
adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not
affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed
severable therefore.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.

Article I: Hours of Certain Playgrounds

[Adopted 5-25-1983 by Ord. No. 1575; amended 6-19-1996 by Ord. No. 2009]

§ 82-1 Hours; areas affected.

The hours of use of the various playgrounds within the Borough of Roselle listed below shall be limited to 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., after which those playgrounds shall be closed to use:

- A. Lincoln School Playground.
- B. Washington School Playground.
- C. Harrison School Playground.
- D. Wilday School Playground.
- E. Arminio Field.
- F. Pine Street Playground.
- G. Christiani Street Basketball Court.
- H. Grove Street Basketball Court.
- I. Rivington Street Playground.
- J. Poplar Street and First Avenue Playground.
- K. Locust School Playground.

Article II: Tot Parks

[Adopted 5-24-1995 by Ord. No. 1973]

§ 82-2 Creation.

Two tot parks shall be created and equipped at the following locations within the Borough of Roselle:

Lot 1, Block 2401, Tax Maps, Roselle.

Lot 1, Block 2203, Tax Maps, Roselle.

§ 82-3 Designation of locations.

The foregoing locations shall be designated as Roselle Tot Park No. 1 and Roselle Tot Park No. 2, respectively.

§ 82-4 Allocation.

The cost allocated for each of said tot parks shall not exceed \$6,500.

§ 82-5 Dedication and maintenance.

The foregoing locations shall be dedicated for recreation use and shall be maintained and administered by the Recreation Committee of the Borough of Roselle.

§ 82-6 Rules and regulations.

[Added 6-19-1996 by Ord. No. 2007; amended 8-21-1996 by Ord. No. 2012]

- A. No children shall be permitted over the age of seven.
- B. No one shall be permitted into the park before 10:00 a.m. or after dark.
- C. There shall be no loitering, eating, drinking or loud noise in the tot park.
- D. The tot park is hereby designated a smoke-free site.
- E. No bicycles or wagons shall be allowed in the tot park.
- F. The gates to the tot park must remain closed at all times.
- G. All children must be accompanied by an adult.^[1]
